




When Childern Play with blocks they are learning...





PLAY DOUGH Recipe

Ingredients:

1 cup flour

1/2 cup salt

2 spoons of cream of tartar

1 tablespoon of cooking oil

1 cup of water

food coloring

Play Dough How-To

- 1. Combine the first four ingredients in a bowl.
- 2. Boil 1 cup of water and then add the food coloring.
- 3. Pour the cup of hot water to your mixture.
- 4. Stir, then knead until smooth.
- 5. On a non-stick pan (for easier stirring), cook your dough to get the consistency that you prefer. Tip: If the play dough is still sticky, just keep stirring and cooking it!
